

SDG1: NO POVERTY

Since the establishment of **The World Islamic Sciences and Education University**, its administration has endeavoured over the years to promote the spirit of social solidarity and the fight against poverty through a number of activities. The first manifestation of such interest consisted of highlighting this issue through clear scientific research efforts made by faculty for the two years, especially in the humanities colleges, specifically the Islamic Sharia colleges. These colleges are based on the principles of the true Islamic religion, which teaches people the spirit of brotherhood and solidarity. The Faculty of Sharia and Fundamentals of Religion is considered one of the most prominent faculties in the university since its inception. The interest in combating poverty became clear through such acts as the establishment of the Poor Student Fund, the reduction of tuition fees for less fortunate students in the Admission and Registration Department and other similar announced laws and policies by the university. One of the most notable programs made by the university to fight poverty was a free e-learning initiative for the whole world in the human sciences. This initiative targeted all groups that cannot directly acquire education, such as the entire continent of Africa, by providing an electronic platform that offers free education for the less fortunate.



In addition to a set of agreements and memoranda of understanding held by the university to propose and provide solutions to the problem of poverty, the most prominent was the
