

SDG2: ZERO HUNGER

The subject of food security and Zero Hunger is another one of the topics covered by the researchers in the economics and administrative sciences at the International University of Islamic Sciences. Food security issues within the subject of economics accounted for 5.4% of the research of the University of Islamic Sciences on the Scopus database with an additional 11.7% connected to social sciences and business.



The subject of food security is one of the most discussed topics in the doctoral and master's programs as indicated by the titles of theses at the Faculty of Finance and Business at the University, which demonstrates profound interest in this topic.

One of the most prominent achievements for **The World Islamic Sciences and Education University** is that it obtained the Crown Prince's Award for the best application of government services on 15 October 2020.
