

SDG6: CLEAN WATER AND SANITATION

The World Islamic Sciences and Education University has placed a high priority on tracking water consumption in the university, with many modern monitoring systems focused on recording consumption rates, and the university has rationalised consumption amounts for individuals and services to meet international standards.

The university has adopted governmental policies to rationalise water consumption and has strengthened these policies strongly and solidly, as evidenced by the fact that all internal facilities are equipped with consumption rationalisation systems, and a detailed irrigation and water consumption program for all purposes in the university has been developed.



The university closely monitors water distribution within its walls, as it is concerned with delivering water to all buildings and providing drinking water directly to all buildings and amenities under a plan aimed at entirely encompassing the campus.



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
