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SDG1: NO POVERTY

The World Islamic Sciences and Education University administration has endeavoured over the years to promote the spirit of social solidarity and the taking action to fight against poverty through a number of activities but the situation was more challenging in 2020-2021 as the whole world was suffering the risk during and after the pandemic (Covid 19) not only as a health crisis but also as a challenging social economic crisis.

The action of fighting poverty was manifested in many dimensions. Financially, the interest in fighting



poverty became clear through such acts as the establishment of the Poor Student Fund, the reduction of tuition fees for unprivileged students in the Admission and Registration Department and other similar laws and policies maintained by the university. One of the most notable programs offered by the university in an attempt to fight poverty was a free e-learning initiative for the

whole world in the human sciences. This initiative targeted all groups that cannot directly acquire education, such as the entire continent of Africa, by providing an electronic platform that offers free education for the unprivileged.

Another decision was made by the head of the trustee council in 2020 to help any student in the university by clearing the outstanding balance in order to help the student to register for the next level/semester and to complete their graduation requirements

At the logistic and social level, **The World Islamic Sciences and Education University** provides free transportation for students within the university campus, and food by making packages of food items or meals, life essentials like blankets for students from low income and organize second hand books exchange activity each academic term in order enable them to complete university.
